(C) M.Sc. Programmes

Admission to all M.Sc. programmes run by the University will be made on the basis of merit list drawn as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of the University Prospectus 2022-23 for Postgraduate Programmes, subject to fulfilling of other conditions given in the Prospectus.

1. Department of Environmental Science & Engineering

M. Sc. (Environmental Sciences) -4 semester

B.Sc./B.Sc.(Hons.) or its equivalent with atleast 50% marks in aggregate (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana)

2. Department of Bio & Nano Technology

(a) M.Sc. (Biotechnology) -4 semester

(b) M.Sc. (Microbiology)-4 semester

(Common Eligibility for above both programmes)

Graduate in any discipline of Biological Science/ Veterinary Science / Agricultural Sciences/ Fishery Sciences/ Pharmacy/ B.Tech. Biotechnology or Medicine (MBBS/BAMS/B.D.S.) with atleast 50% marks (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana).

3. Department of Food Technology

M.Sc. (Food Technology) -4 semester

Graduate in any discipline of Science / Engineering/ Technology with atleast 50% marks aggregate (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana).

4. Department of Chemistry

M.Sc. (Chemistry) -4 semester

B.Sc.(Hons.) in Chemistry or Industrial Chemistry with atleast 50% marks (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana)

OR

B.Sc. with atleast 50% marks in aggregate with Chemistry as one of the subjects in each semester/ year of B.Sc. degree (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana).

5. Department of Mathematics

M. Sc. (Mathematics) -4 semester

B.A.(Hons.)/ B.Sc.. (Hons.) in Mathematics with atleast 50% marks (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana)

OR

B.A./B.Sc. with atleast 50% marks in aggregate with Mathematics as one of the subjects in each Semester/ Year of B.A./ B.Sc. degree (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana).

6. Department of Physics

M.Sc. (Physics) -4 semester

B.Sc.(Hons.) in Physics with atleast 50% marks (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana)

OR

B.Sc. with atleast 50% marks in aggregate with Physics as one of the subjects in each Semester/ Year of B.Sc. degree (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana).

7. Department of Applied Psychology

M.Sc. (Psychology) -4 semester

Graduate in any discipline with atleast 50% marks in aggregate (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana)

8. Department of Economics

M.Sc. (Economics)–4 semester

A candidate with atleast 50% marks (47.5% for SC candidates of Haryana) from a recognized University/ Institute with Economics or Mathematics as one of the subjects at undergraduate level or with Mathematics as one of the subjects in class XII.

9. Department of Physiotherapy

M.Sc. (Yoga Science & Therapy)–4 semester

Bachelor Degree in any discipline or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with atleast 50% marks (47.5% for SC candidates of Haryana).

(D) MASTER OF PHYSIOTHERAPY PROGRAMMES

Admission to Master of Physiotherapy programmes run by the University will be made on the basis of merit list drawn as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of the University Prospectus 2022-23 for Postgraduate Programmes, subject to fulfilling of other conditions given in the Prospectus.

Department of Physiotherapy

- a. Master of Physiotherapy (Orthopaedics) (2 years, Annual system)
- b. Master of Physiotherapy (Sports) (2 years, Annual system)
- c. Master of Physiotherapy (Neurology) (2 years, Annual system)
- d. Master of Physiotherapy (Cardiothoracic & Pulmonary Disorder) (2 years, Annual system)

A Candidate who has passed Bachelor of Physiotherapy from any Indian/Foreign Universities/ Board aggregate 55% marks (52.25% for SC candidates of Haryana) in Bachelor of Physiotherapy or from recognized college and has completed six months of compulsory rotatory internship.

(E) MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (M.B.A.) and M.Com. PROGRAMMES

Haryana School of Business

The candidates possessing the following qualifications are eligible for admission to the respective programmes of Haryana School of Business:

MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Admission to MBA Programmes will be made on the basis of merit of valid CAT score 2021 (80 % weightage), Group Discussion (10% weightage) and Personal Interview (10% weightage). If the seats still remain vacant due to non-availability of valid CAT score candidates, the same will be filled on the basis of Merit list of entrance test (80% weightage), Group Discussion (10% weightage) and Personal Interview (10% weightage) as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of the University Prospectus for the Postgraduate Programmes for the session 2022-23, subject to fulfilling of other conditions given in the Prospectus. For Admission to MBA programmes, the candidates must appear for both Group Discussion and Personal Interview. The candidates are required to apply online by visiting on the University website.

Eligibility criteria for MBA, MBA International Business, MBA Marketing and MBA Finance

Graduation in any stream with at least 50% marks (47.5% for SC candidates of Haryana) from recognized university.

Eligibility criteria for MBA Business Analytics:

- (i) Graduation in any stream with at least 50% marks (47.5% for SC candidates of Haryana) from recognized university.
- (ii) However, those candidates who have studied mathematics at secondary level/equivalent level or at graduation level/equivalent level will be given preference and other (candidates without studied mathematics at secondary level/equivalent level or at graduation level/equivalent level, whatsoever may be valid CAT score/entrance test score) may be considered for admission in this programme, if seats remain vacant may be considered for admission in this programme, if seats remain vacant.

MASTER OF COMMERCE

Admission to M.Com. Programme will be made on the basis of Merit of entrance test (80% weightage), Group Discussion (10% weightage) and Personal Interview (10% weightage) as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of the University Prospectus for the Postgraduate Programmes for the session 2022-23, subject to fulfilling of other conditions given in the Prospectus. For Admission to M.Com programme, the candidates must appear for both Group Discussion and Personal Interview. The candidates are required to apply online by visiting on the University website.

Eligibility criteria for M.Com.:

Any Commerce graduate/ BA with Economics/ BBA/equivalent with at least 50% marks (47.5% for SC category of Haryana) from a recognized University.

Note:

1. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for GD and PI for admission to MBA and M.Com. programmes.
2. All updates related to admission would be available on the university website and no separate correspondence would be made in this regard.

(F) MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS PROGRAMME

Admission to MCA programme will be made on the basis of merit list drawn as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of the University Prospectus 2022-23 for Postgraduate Programmes, subject to fulfilling of other conditions given in the Prospectus.

Department of Computer Science & Engineering

MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (MCA)-4 semester

Passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science & Engineering/Computer Science/Computer Engineering or equivalent Degree.

OR

Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level (with additional bridge Courses as per the norms of the concerned University).

Obtained atleast 50% marks (47.5% for SC candidates of Haryana) in the qualifying Examination.

Note: Candidates having passed Mathematics/ Statistics in one semester/ in one year as the case may be shall be considered eligible for MCA.

(G) M.A. PROGRAMMES

Admission to M.A. programmes will be made on the basis of merit list drawn as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of the University Prospectus 2022-23 for Postgraduate Programmes, subject to fulfilling of other conditions given in the Prospectus.

1. Department of Communication Management & Technology (CM&T)

M.A. (Mass Communication) – 4 semester

Graduate in any discipline with atleast 50% marks (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana)

2. Department of English

(Mentor Department is Communication Management & Technology)

M.A (English)– 4 semester under CBCS

Bachelor Degree with atleast 50% marks in aggregate (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana).

3. M.A (Hindi) – 4 semester

Bachelor Degree with atleast 50% marks in aggregate (pass marks for SC candidates of Haryana).

(H) POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA(S)

Admission to PG Diploma(s) will be made on the basis of merit list drawn as per criteria given in Chapter-5 of the University Prospectus 2022-23 for Postgraduate Programmes, subject to fulfilling of other conditions given in the Prospectus.
