(viii) Bachelor of Physiotherapy (4 years, Annual Scheme+ 6 Months compulsory Internship)

Candidate should have qualified 10+2 examination with pass marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English from Board of School Education, Haryana or equivalent examination from a recognized Board / University.

Or

Candidates who have studied abroad and have passed the equivalent examination as per the guidelines of the Association of Indian Universities to determine the eligibility and must have passed in the subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English up to 10+2 Standard level.

Candidates should have attained age of 17 years as on 31st December of concerned year.

It is pertinent to mention here that for Admission to Bachelor of Physiotherapy: Candidate who fails to attend the Medical Examination on the notified dates(s) will forfeit the claim for admission and placement in the waiting list except permitted by the competent authority under special circumstances.

(ix) B.A. (Mass Communication)

Candidate should have qualified 10+2 examination with 50% marks (47.5% for SC candidates of Haryana) from Board of School Education Haryana or equivalent examination from a recognized Board/ University.

(x) B.Voc. (Food Processing and Engineering)

A candidate must have passed 10+2 examinations (any stream) or vocational from any recognized board or university with a minimum of 50% marks (47.5% for SC candidates of Haryana).

Admission to Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.) Physics - M.Sc. (Physics), Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.) Chemistry - M.Sc. (Chemistry), Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons.) Mathematics - M.Sc. (Mathematics), Dual Degree B.Sc. (Hons) Biotechnology - M.Sc. (Biotechnology), B.Sc. (Hons.) - Computer (Data Science), B.Sc. (Hons.) - Economics and B.Sc. (Hons.) - Psychology, Bachelor of Physiotherapy and B.A. (Mass Communication) for the session 2022-23 will be based on the basis of the score in the Entrance Test and on the basis of criteria mentioned in chapter 5 of the University Prospectus 2022-23, subject to fulfilling other conditions given in the University Prospectus 2022-23. The admission to B.Voc (Food Processing and Engineering) will be made on the basis of academic merit of the qualifying examination and sports weightage, if any.

| 1. | <p>A candidate who has passed one of the following examinations with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the course:</p> <p>For B.A./ B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least <u>33% marks</u> in aggregate for admission to B.A. (General) course and at least <u>40% marks</u> in aggregate in Science Group for admission to B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) course(s).</p> <p>For B.A./ B.Sc. (Hons.) Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana or an equivalent examination with at least <u>50% marks</u> in aggregate or 50% marks in the subject offered for the Honours Course.</p> <p>Note:-</p> <p>(i) A candidate who has been placed under compartment or allowed to re-appear in one subject only in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana, or equivalent examination of another University/ Board obtaining at least 33% or 40% marks in the aggregate respectively, may be allowed to study provisionally for the B.A./ B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) 1st Semester Class. Such a candidate shall be allowed to clear the compartment/ reappear subject before commencement of the examination of 1st semester of the B.A./ B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) and Honours Course of the University. If a candidate does not clear his/her compartment/ reappear subject even before commencement of the 1st Semester examination, his/her provisional admission to B.A./ B.Sc. (Part-I) shall be cancelled ab initio. However, the Vice-Chancellor may relax it in hard & exceptional cases, on the recommendations of a Committee to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.</p> <p>(ii) In case of the candidate who has been placed under compartment/ re-appear in one subject only in the qualifying examination and seeks admission to B.A./ B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) First Semester course under above clause, the required percentage of marks for admission shall be determined by taking into account the minimum pass marks in compartment/ re-appear subject.</p> <p>(iii) A candidate of another University/ Board who did not pass in the subject of English or any one deficient subject, in the Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of Board of School Education, Haryana or in an examination recognized as equivalent thereto, may be allowed to join the B.A./ B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) First Semester class provisionally subject to his/her qualifying in the subject of English or any one deficient subject of 10+2 standard examination at the:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(a) Supplementary examination of the same year; OR (b) Annual Examination of the following year.</p> |

Provided that his/her result of B.A./ B.Sc. Semesters I and II Examinations shall be declared only after he /she has qualified in the required subject. If he/she does not clear the subject of English or any one deficient subject even in the second chance, his/her provisional admission/ result of B.A./ B.Sc. I and II Semester shall be cancelled ab initio.

A candidate, who has passed one of the following examinations with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the B.Com. course:

For Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.)

Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or as examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least 40% marks in the Commerce Group or 50% marks in the Non-Commerce Group (Humanities & Science with Mathematics)

Note:-

- (i) A candidate who has been placed under compartment or allowed to re-appear in one subject only in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana, or equivalent examination of another University/ Board obtaining at least 40% marks in the aggregate in Commerce Group or 50% marks in Non-Commerce Group (Humanities & Science with Mathematics), may be allowed to read provisionally for the B.Com. 1st Semester class. Such a candidate shall be allowed to clear the compartment/ re-appear subject before commencement of the examination of 1st semester of the B.Com. Course of the University. If a candidate does not clear his/her compartment/ reappear subject even before commencement of the 1st Semester examination, his/her provisional admission to B.Com. (Part-I) shall be cancelled ab initio. However, the Vice-Chancellor may relax it, in hard & exceptional cases, on the recommendations of a Committee to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.
- (ii) In case of the candidate who has been placed under compartment/ re-appear in one subject only in the qualifying examination and seeks admission to B.Com. first semester course under above clause, the required percentage of marks for admission shall be determined by taking into account the minimum pass marks in compartment/re-appear subject.
- (iii) A candidate of another University/ Board who did not pass in the subject of English or any one deficient subject in the Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of Board of School Education, Haryana or in an examination recognized as equivalent thereto, may be allowed to join the B.Com. first semester class provisionally subject to his/her qualifying in the subject of English or any one deficient subject of 10+2 standard examination at the :
 - (a) Supplementary examination of the same year;
 - OR
 - (b) Annual Examination of the following year.

Provided that his/her result of B.Com. Semester I and II Examinations shall be declared only after he/she has qualified in the required subject. If he/she does not clear the subject of English or any one deficient subject even in the second chance, his/her provisional admission/ result of B.Com. I and II Semesters shall be cancelled ab initio.
